Piano Skills (Level 2)

Objectives

At the end of this course participants will be able to: play one piece of music on the keyboard with their own decisions of accompaniment style read and play chords according to chord symbols understand what skills they need to develop when listening to, and learning music be aware of personal habits and areas to focus on approach learning music with patience and sensitivity to their personal needs

Skills the course covers: physicality and technique of keyboard playing reading, interpreting and applying chord symbols to playing keyboard developments for playing accompaniment on the piano basic ear training and musicality reading staff notation in treble clef physical, psychological and emotional factors when approaching learning music

Jane Foo is a musician, piano accompanist and educator. She believes making music is about being present, listening, feeling and connecting with oneself and with others.

A NAFA graduate, he blends instrumental and theory instruction with piano accompaniment. His students have earned distinctions in ABRSM exams and top prizes in competitions such as Music Singapore and Vienna Virtuoso Festival. Pre-requisites for Level 2

Participants should already be able to: play a simple piece on the piano read and play from staff notation OR from chord symbols

In order for the trainer to gauge if the course is appropriate for the current ability of the participant, applicants are required to send in a short video of themselves playing a simple piece of the piano. The piece of music should be played from start till end without interruptions. The piece of music should be 30 seconds to 1 minute long. The video should clearly show the the top half of the piano player's body i.e. from the waist to the face, including hands.
